Who greeters are: Greeters are the “open arms” of St. Francis of Assisi Parish – parish volunteers who represent the entire church family not only creating a family spirit to all our current parishioners but also providing an avenue for all those interested in becoming new members. We see the future of St. Francis of Assisi Parish as a community of God’s people built on the respect and support of one another while sharing the message of God’s unconditional love through Jesus Christ.

What greeters do: We offer a warm word of welcome to visitors and parishioners:

- on occasion, answer basic questions about the parish,

- open doors for people who might need assistance.

Time commitment: Greeters arrive at least 20-30 minutes before the designated service and stay at the doors, front and tower doors, until after worship begins.
